For your convenience, we have listed some methods to solve common problems you may encounter when you using the system . If the problem occurs repeatedly , contact the nearest maintenance center .






- Use only the power source which corresponds to the requirements stated in this manual or on the unit.



MENU SETUP

Password Setup Page



1. Parental Control

This unit has 8 different age ratings that can be selected. Move the cursor to select one of them, then press Play/Enter button on the remote control to enter. You are reminded to input the password.


2. Password

The original password of this unit is" 138900" and you can change it to a new one.

REMOTE CONTROL

NOTE:


- 1. Turn on the player, insert the batteries into the remote control, and direct the remote controller at the remote sensor on the front panel .
- 2. Remote controls functions at the distance of 7 m (not more) from the player.
- 3. If the remote control sensor or IR-radiator is closed ,the remote control will not operate or there will be interference in the work.
- 4. Interference from the high tension appliances, generating high frequency signal can strongly influence the work of the remote control.



CONNECT TO THE TV-SET

- 1. If your TV-set has AV input, use the AV cable to connect the player to the TV-set.

 Afterwards make sure the connection is right; by selecting AV status for your TV-set.
- 2. If your TV-set has S-video input, use S-video cable to connect the player to the TV-set. This type of connection provides the best quality of picture.
- 3. If your TV-set has Pb/Cb, Y, Pr/C/r input, use six headed jack cable to connect the player to the TV-set. This type of connection makes the picture more natural.
- 4. This unit has HDMI output, which can directly be connected with TV-set. This type of connection provides better picture quality.




NOTES:

- 1. Before connecting the player to the TV-set; turn off and unplug the both units.
- 2. When a disc is being played, we recommend changing the settings of the player in order to make it compatible with the TV-set .
- 3. You can connect the player to the TV-set in different ways. Choose only one of them as multiple connections negatively influence the source and picture quality.
- 4. Do not turn ON/OFF the player repeatedly ;allow for intervals of minimum 3 seconds in between.
- 5. Do not use digital optical or coaxial output of the player and analogue output at the same time.

MENU SETUP

System Setup Page



1. Angle Mark

When the disc has multi-angle pictures, setting the Angle Mark displays a multi-angle mark on the screen ,This option has two settings :

ON: Display multi-angle mark

OFF: Multi-angle mark is not displayed

2. Close Caption

When playing a DVD, set this option OFF to close caption, choose the ON option to open the caption.

3. Screen saver

To set screen saver on or off.

4. Memory

When the option is set to ON, the system remembers the played discs contents. The disc content is not remembered when the OFF option is selected.

5. S/W Version (Software Version)

This option is used to display the model of this system and its factory name.

6. Default

While in EJECT or NO DISC status, this option is chosen to reset the DVD player's original setup.

MENU SETUP

2) Bass Boost

It use to adjust the sound effect of Bass boost to ON or OFF.

3) Super Bass

ON: set the super bass on, and adjust the super bass effect.

OFF: set the super bass off.

4) Treble Boost

ON: set the treble boost on and adjust the treble effect.

OFF: set the super treble boost off.

5. 3D Processing

PRO LOGIC II

In this option, when ON is selected, the sound of 2CH will be dummy in 5CH, and transmit through 5CH. If the TITLE does not support this function, the effect will be worse by selecting ON. So in this case, you are suggested to select AUTO.

1) PRO LOGIC II Mode (Music, Movie, PRO LOGIC, Auto)

In Music mode, all the voice of channels can reach at the same time, without delay; In Movie mode, the surround channel is added 10ms delay; PRO LOGIC mode is the emulation of PRO LOGIC I; In Auto mode, the player choose the mode according to the disc automatically.

2) Panorama

When ON option is chosen, the voice of front stereo spread to the two sides, and make a better enveloped felling.

- 3) Dimension: This function is used to adjust the front and rear sound fields, which is similar to the balance control between front and rear speakers. There are seven options for selecting.
- 4) Centre width: To adjust the centre signal to transmit left and right channels, and emit out from the three front speakers with different degrees.

Note: When PRO LOGIC II is set to be OFF, the above four options are unavailable.

• Reverb Mode

This option is use to select the reverb mode from: Concert, Living room, Hall, Bathroom, Cave, Arena, Church.


CONNECT TO AMPLIFIER

Digital audio output setting

Connect coaxial or optical output of the player to the corresponding inputs of the amplifier. When a disc is in play or stop mode, press the <u>SETUP</u> button on the remote Control to open the DVD MENUsetup. Use direction buttons to move to audio setup page. Move the cursor to SPDIF setup, select the digital output and set SPDIF/RAW or SPDIF/PCM. Then press the <u>PLAY/ENTER</u> button to save the selected value. To exit the setup Menu press the SETUP button again.

The setting of 5.1 channel output

Connect the 5.1 Channel output to the 5.1 channel input terminal of the amplifier. Press the <u>SETUP</u> button to enter DVD menu setup; open the AUDIO setup page; select speaker setup and set the DOWNMIX to 5.1CH.



Preparation

- 1) Before the unit is turned on, please check if all the connections are right and safely made. Insert the plug in the corresponding power socket.
- 2) Press the <u>POWER</u> button on the front panel of this unit.
- 3) To move the disc holder out press the <u>EJECT</u> button on the remote control or the front panel of this unit. Put the disc on the disc holder and press the <u>EJECT</u> button Again. The player will start loading a disc and playing a disc automatically.

Mute button

If you press the <u>MUTE</u> button while playing, sound signal will not be heard, but the picture will remain. Press the <u>MUTE</u> button again or the <u>VOL+/-</u> buttons to resume the previous volume level.

State indication

While playing a disc, press the <u>DISPLAY</u> button, the following information will appear on the display:

VCD/CD items: single elapsed, single remain, total elapsed, total remain, display off.

DVD items: title elapsed, title remain, chapter elapsed, chapter remain, display off.

Select channel/language

During a VCD or a CD disc playing ,press the <u>L/R/LANG</u> button to select one of the playing modes: Mono L, Mono R and Stereo. Press the button once to switch to one of channel modes.

During a DVD-disc playing ,use the <u>L/R/LANG</u> button to select sound language provided(For a DVD- disc supports this function).

Fast Forward and Rewind

When playing a disc, press the ◀ or ▶ button to fast forward and fast rewind. The speed changes in the following way:

Fast Forward: 2 times faster, 4 times faster, 8 times faster, 16 times faster, 32 times faster, play.

Back forward: 2 times faster, 4 times faster, 8 times faster, 16 times faster, 32 times faster, play.

Previous and next

When playing a disc press the ► button to go to the previous song or the ► button to go to the next song.

MENU SETUP

Audio Setup Page



1. Speaker Setup

• Downmix Mode

LT/RT: left and right soundtrack audio output

Stereo: Stereo audio signal output

- 5.1 CH: set the 5.1 CH audio output.
- Front, Centre and Rear speakers control the volume of corresponding output audio.
- Subwoofer: To set subwoofer on or off.
- Dual Mono

This option is used to set the mode of audio output, including L-Mono, R-Mono, Mix-Mono, and Stereo.

• Dynamic range

This option is chosen when Line output is selected for the compression mode. Linear compression ratio is adjusted to acquire different compression effects.

2. SPDIF Setup

• Digital Output

When playing DOLBY or MPEG discs, the coaxial and optical terminal outputs in SPDIF/RAW format. Meanwhile the connected amplifier must be able to decode the DOLBY DIGITAL or MPEG.


SPDIF/PCM may be selected when the player is connected with a 2CH digital stereo amplifier

- 3. Channel Delay
- To set the delay effect of channels.
- 4. Equalizer
- 1) Sound Mode

This option is used to select the different balanced effect, such as OFF, ROCK, POP, LIVE, DANCE, TECHNO, CLASSIC, SOFT.

MENU SETUP

Video Setup Page



1. Video Output

This option is used to set the video output mode: S-Video, YUV. Note: Make sure that you set the player to the correct video mode.

- 2. Aspect Ratio (4:3PS, 4:3LB,16:9)
- No matter which format you select, if the screen is 4:3 display, the image is displayed in 4:3.
- The DVD screen format is changeable.
- When the screen displays in 4:3, the display format of DVD is 16:9, the image will be compressed horizontally.

3. TV Output

This system supports the following formats: PAL, AUTO, NTSC.

4. Quality

You can adjust the video output of sharpness, brightness, contrast, gamma, hue, saturation, luma delay according to your favor.

The adjustable range of sharpness is: High, Medium and Low.

The adjustable range of brightness is: ± -20 (default is 0).

The adjustable range of contrast is: ± -16 (default is 0).

The adjustable range of hue and saturation are:+/-9 (default is 0).

The adjustable range of gamma is: High, Medium, Low and None.

5. Resolution

This option is used to choose the resolution for HDMI.

6. HDMI Setup

1)HDMI

You can set the HDMI ON/OFF with this option.

2) Audio Source

There are two audio formats for selecting: Auto and PCM.

BASIC OPERATIONS

Repeat

While in playing mode, press the <u>REPEAT</u> button to set repeat mode.

- For DVD, as you press the <u>REPEAT</u> button, the TV screen will displays: Chapter, Title, All.
- 2. For VCD, CD, CD-R discs, press the <u>REPEAT</u> button, the screen will displays: Track, All.
- 3. For MP3, JPEG and other media files, the screen will displays: Single, Repeat one, Repeat Folder, Folder.

A-B Repeat

While in playing mode, press the REP. AB button to set the section for repeating .

- 1. Press the <u>REP.AB</u> button once at the beginning of the section (A).
- 2. Press the <u>REP.AB</u> button at the end of the section (B). Then it will automatically repeat section AB.
- 3. Press the button again to exit.

Standby mode

To switch on (or switch off) the standby mode ,press the <u>POWER</u> button on the remote control (make sure that the unit is connected to the power source).

Title

If the DVD disc contains a directory volume; press the \underline{TITLE} button to display the list of titles on this disc .Use the direction button to move the cursor or digital buttons to select the items that you want to play .

Volume setting

Press the <u>VOL.+/-</u> buttons to turn the volume up or down.

Slow

In play status, every time the <u>SLOW</u> button is pressed, the speed of the disc will play in 1/2,1/4,1/8,1/16.

Subtitle

If a DVD-disc supports subtitle languages, use the <u>SUB</u> button to select one of the languages: English, French, German, Spanish, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Thai.

Stop

In playing mode, press the <u>STOP</u> button once, the player will stop the playing; the stop position will be memorized. Press <u>PLAY/ENTER</u> button, the disc will play from the previous stop position.

If you press the <u>STOP</u> button twice, stop position will not be memorised, press the <u>PLAY/ENTER</u> button, the player will start from the beginning.

Menu

While playing a VCD, press the $\underline{\text{MENU}}$ button , PBC current state view mode will be opened /close on the remote control.

Note:

- 1. During playing DVD, press the MENU button to go into the root menu status.
- 2. Some pirate discs do not support this function.

Angle view selection

While in play mode, press the <u>ANGLE</u> button to switch angle view (if a disc support this function).

Digital buttons

While playing audio files, press the <u>DIGITAL</u> button to input the number of the required track.

If the number of the track consists of two digits, press the $\underline{10+}$ button, then input the second digit of the number. For instance, input 16, press the $\underline{10+}$ button and then press the $\underline{6}$ button.

Pause

During playing a disc, press the <u>PAUSE</u> button to pause, press the button again or <u>PLAY/ENTER</u> button to continue the playing.

Direction buttons

Press the direction buttons to move the cursor.

Play/Enter

Press PLAY/ENTER button to enable the selected items.

Video mode

Press <u>V.MODE</u> button to select video mode from the following modes: S-video, YUV..

Clear

Press <u>CLEAR</u> button to cancel the data you have entered . For example: the setting of programmed songs.

Zaam

In the play status, every time the <u>ZOOM</u> button is pressed, the TV screen will be zoomed in or out proportionally. If the zoom proportion more than 1, pressing this button continuously, the screen will display: zoom in 2,3,4,1/2, 1/3,1/4.

MENU SETUP


DVD MENU SETUP

To access the DVD menu:

- 1. Press the SETUP button.
- 2. Press the direction buttons to switch between the different setup pages.
- 3. Press the direction button to move the cursor to the position you want, then press the PLAY/ENTER button again to enter the subdirectory.
- 4. Press the <u>PLAY/ENTER</u> buttons again to enter the next subdirectory.

Note: In any menu, you can press the up and down direction buttons to move the cursor and press the <u>PLAY/ENTER</u> button to enter the selected items. Pressing the <u>SETUP</u> button to exit the system setup.

DVD Setup Page



1. OSD Language

This option is used to select the language of all the screen displays and setup menus. You can set the OSD language to English or Japanese.

2. Audio Language

When playing a DVD, the player will automatically play the built-in language of the disc. This unit can play the following languages: English, French, German, Spanish, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Thai and others.

3. Subtitle Language

When playing a DVD, the player will automatically play the built-in subtitle language of the disc. The unit has the following built-in languages: English, French, German, Spanish, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Thai and others. You can select any one as the built-in subtitle or close the subtitle.

4. Menu Language

The unit has 8 menu languages available: English, French, German, Spanish, Chinese, Japanese, Korean Thai and others.

- 2. Press the <u>up/down</u> direction button to select the required directory. To view it keep pressing the <u>PLAY/ENTER</u> button till the required picture is found.
- 3. To view a picture input its number using the number buttons or <u>PREV./NEXT</u> buttons.
- 4. JPEG picture may be distort at the edge of some TV sets . This is caused by the TV and not your system.
- 5. This system can play digital JPEG-file photo discs, and also support photos created by photoshop.
- 6. To repeat viewing a picture, pressing the REPEAT button.
- 7. While playing, press the <u>STOP</u> button to return to the main menu .You can also use such options like fast forward , rewind , pause, ect

BASIC OPERATIONS

Reset

In any status, pressing \underline{RESET} button can return to the original setup or the default value.

Shortcut


When playing DVD discs, press the <u>SHORTCUT</u> button to skip the initial title menu or warnings (If the disc supports this function).

2/5.1CH


When playing DVD(with 5.1 CH output) discs, press this button to switch between Downmix Stereo (2.1 CH) and Downmix 5.1CH.

Program

• In play VCD/CD, press <u>PROGRAM</u> button, the TV screen shows:



• In play DVD, press <u>PROGRAM</u> button, the TV screen shows:



- 1. If the player is in the PBC ON status, while playing the programmed songs this operation will result in PBC turning off.
- 2. Input the number that you want at the place of the cursor; move the cursor to START; press the PLAY/ENTER button the songs will play in the specified order.
- 3. While in programming mode, press CLEAR button to eliminate the digitals that you are input.
- 4.To exit programmed play: press PROGRAM button again, the cursor move to stop automatically; press PLAY/ENTER button, the cursor move to Exit automatically; press PLAY/ENTER button again to cancel programmed playing.


Time selection

In play status, press <u>T/F</u> button on the remote controller, the TV screen displays,

VCD disc display:



DVD disc display:



You can press the direction key to move the cursor to the setting option according to the above-mentioned screen suggestions, then press <u>Play/Enter</u> to confirm and use number keys to input the corresponding time numbers, after it is done, DVD player will start to play according to the setting time. When press the Down direction button, you can see the next item in the above screen.

There are 5 items in VCD screen: Track, Disc time, Track time, Repeat, Time DISP (Display); 9 items in DVD screen: Title, Track, Audio, Subtitle, Angle, TT(Total) time, CH(Chapter) time, Repeat, Time DISP(Display).

Note: The optional time range depends on the volume of discs.

While playing CD, MP3 or Mp4, press <u>T/F</u> button to switch between the ``Time Selection (current song/chapter)`` and ``Song/Chapter Selection``; then input the digital you want. The system begins playing from the specified time/song/chapter.

DVD title menu selection


DVD discs with more than one movie, background data , and /or songs are given the name TITLE, while more sections are displayed under each TITLE , called Chapters. Chapter can contain musical or video clips . While playing DVD disc, press the TITLE button , and the TITLE menu appear s on the TV screen. (Available for DVDs that contain more than one title menu .)

Press the direction buttons to move the cursor to the desired title menu , then press the $\underline{PLAY/ENTER}$ button to play it . If the title menu is represented by numbers , then press the number buttons to select it directly .

BASIC OPERATIONS

MP3 disc playing function

1. Press the <u>EJECT</u> button on the front panel or the remote control (or front panel) to open the disc tray. Insert the MP3 disc and press the <u>EJECT</u> button again to close it. The system will read the disc and the TV will display the following picture:



- 2. Press the direction button to move the cursor to a directory , the press the <u>PLAY/</u> ENTER button to enter the directory .
- 3. Press the direction buttons to enter the subdirectory or the file area, select a song with the cursor, then press the PLAY/ENTER button to play the song.
- To select other songs under the current directory during playing, press up or down Direction button ,or PREV. /NEXT.
- To change directories during playing, press the left direction button to move the icon to the directory symbol, press the up/down direction button to select other directories, then press the PLAY/ENTER button.

MPEG4/JPEG-disc playing

1. Put a MPEG4/ JPEG-disc in the slot, after loading the disc, the TV will display following picture:
