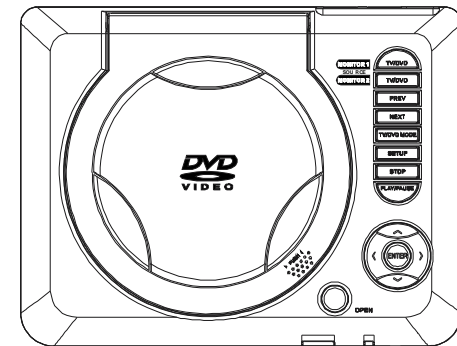
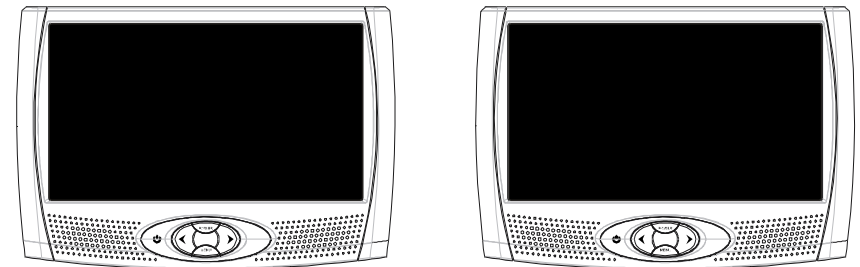

Troubleshooting(Continued)

There is a CR 2025 battery for remote control.

DISC handling and maintenance

Handling precautions

- Hold the disc by the edges so the surface will not be soiled with fingerprints. Fingerprints, dirt and scratches can cause skipping and distortion.

Troubleshooting

Before requesting service for this player, check the chart below for a possible cause of the problem you are experiencing. Some simple checks or an adjustment on your part may eliminate the problem and restore proper operation.

- Do not use record cleaning sprays, benzine, thinner, static electricity prevention liquids.

If the surface is soiled

Wipe gently with a soft, damp (water only) cloth.
When wiping discs, always move the cloth from the centre hole toward the outside, which will not cause distortion. (If you wipe the discs using a circular motion, circular scratches are likely to occur, which will cause distortion.)

If the disc is brought from a cold to a warm environment moisture may form on the disc

Wipe this moisture off with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth before using the disc.

Improper disc storage

You can damage discs if you store them in the following places:

- Areas exposed to direct sunlight
- Humid or dusty areas
- Areas directly exposed to a heat outlet or heating appliance

Maintenance

- Be sure to press POWER to set the player to the standby mode and disconnect the AC adaptor before maintaining the player.
- Wipe the player with a dry, soft cloth.
- If the surfaces are extremely dirty ,wipe clean with a cloth which has been dipped in a weak soap-and-water solution and wrung out thoroughly, and then wipe again with a dry cloth.
- Never use alcohol, benzine, thinner, cleaning fluid or other chemicals. And do not use compressed air to remove dust



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Definition of Terms

DVD

This refers to a high-density optical disc on which high-quality pictures and sound have been obtained by means of digital signals. Incorporation a new video compression technology (MPEG II) and high-density recording technology, DVD enables aesthetically pleasing full-motion video to be recorded over long periods of time (for instance, a whole movie can be recorded). DVD has a structure consisting of two 0.6 mm thin discs which are adhered to each other. Since the thinner the disc, the higher the density at which the information can be recorded, a DVD disc has a greater capacity than a single 1.2 mm thick disc. Since the two thin discs are adhered to each other, there is the potential to achieve double-sided play sometime in the future for even longer duration play.

Video CD

This contains recordings of pictures and sound whose quality is on a par with that of video tape. This player also supports Video CDs with playback control (version 2.0).

MP3

These contain recordings of music which are compressed, allowing a significantly larger amount of music to be stored on a CD.

Angle

Recorded onto some DVD discs are scenes which have been simultaneously shot from a number of different angles (the same scene is shot from the front, from the left side, from the right side, etc.). With such discs, the ANGLE button can be used to view the scene from different angles.

Subtitles

This is the appearance of the dialogue at the bottom of the screen which are pre-recorded on some DVD discs.

Title number

These numbers are recorded on DVD discs. When a disc contains two or more movies, these movies are numbered as title 1, title 2, etc.

Chapter number

These numbers are recorded on DVD discs. A title is sub- divided into many sections, each of which is numbered, and specific parts of video presentations can be searched quickly using these numbers.

Time number

This indicates the play time which has elapsed from the start of a disc or a title. It can be used to find a specific scene quickly.(It may not work with some discs.)

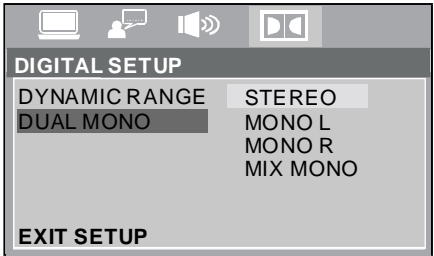
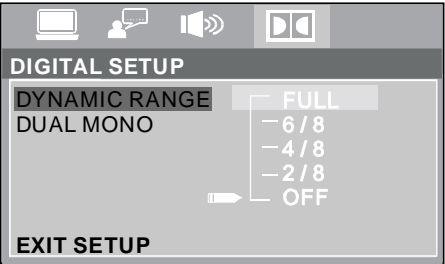
Playback control (PBC)

This is recorded on a Video CD (version 2.0). The scenes or information to be viewed (or listened to) can be selected interactively with the TV monitor by looking at the menu shown on the TV monitor.

Track number

These numbers are assigned to the tracks which are recorded on Video CDs and CDs. They enable specific tracks to be located quickly.

4.DIGITAL SETUP



Features

DUAL 7" TFT SCREENS

This player is accompanied by dual 7" TFT screens to provide clear vision, and low radiation.

MULTI TV SYSTEM SUPPORT

The player can play discs with signal system of PAL and NTSC.

GRAPHICAL USER INTERFACE SCREEN

Simply pressing the DISPLAY button on the remote control, information on the player and disc can be displayed on the TV screen for easy identification, The player's operations and settings can be performed by operating the remote control while monitoring screen.

MULTI-AUDIO FUNCTION

The audio sound track can be heard in up to 8 languages. (The number of audio sound languages depends on the software.)

MULTI-SUBTITLES FUNCTION

Subtitles may be displayed in one of a maximum of 32 languages depending on the software.

MULTI-ANGLE FUNCTION

This function allows you to choose the viewing angle of scenes which were shot from a number of different angles. (Limited to DVD recorded with multiple camera angles.)

PARENTAL LOCK FUNCTION

This prevents playing discs unsuitable for children.

USB/CARD READER FUNCTION

This player supports reading USB/SD /MMC card containing files in VCD/ SVCD/ DVD/ MP3/ WMA/MP4/JPEG /CD format.
(NOTE: The USB port of this unit cannot connect with the removable HDD.)

Important Notes to control either DVD/USB/SD or TV

Prebis DP-S1400TV allows you to watch DVD/USB/SD and TV independently or separately.

1/. Go to control TV :

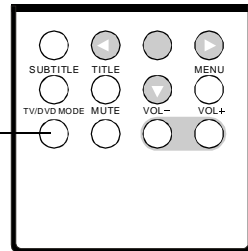
Press **TV/DVD MODE** once, both monitors will appear  logo. You are free to operate TV. Please note DVD,USB or SD will not work.

2/. Go to play DVD, USD or SD :

Press **TV/DVD MODE** once AGAIN, both monitors will appear  logo. You are free to operate DVD, USB or SD. Please note TV will not work.



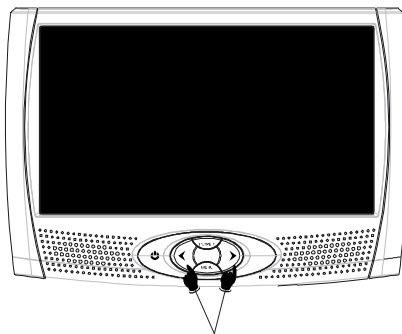

Important Notes to adjust volume level of your preferences

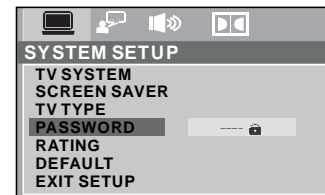
There are 2 separate volume controls. One is from remote control and the other is from both monitors. Both monitors' volume levels are default at level 10 while unit volume level is default at level 15. If you want to adjust the volume, press the volume button of each monitor individually.



Press **LEFT/RIGHT** button on the monitor to adjust volume level of your preference

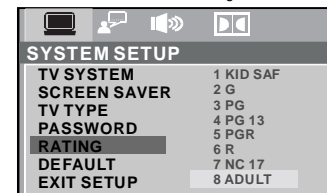
- 4:3 PS: choosing this setting if your DVD player is connected to a normal TV (4:3 ratio). You can fill the movie to the entire screen of you TV. This might mean that parts of the picture (the left and right edges) won't be seen.
- 4:3 LB: Choosing this setting if your DVD player is connected to a normal TV (4:3 ratio). Selecting this setting you'll see the entire frame of the movie, but it will take up a smaller portion of the screen vertically. The movie might appear with black bars at the top of the screen.
- 16:9: Choose this setting if your DVD player is connected to a wide screen TV.

1.4 PASSWORD- It is used to set the password.



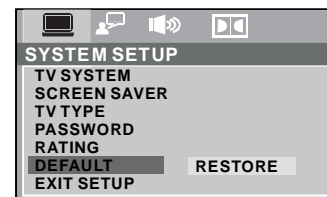
When the player is locked, you need to enter the password in order to play discs that you have a higher rating than what you've allowed. If the player is unlocked, no password is required to play discs. Even if you've set rating limits, they won't be enforced until the player is locked. Use the number buttons to enter your password and press ENTER. The parental controls are now unlocked and you can change the ratings to the desired settings. If you forgot your password, enter the factory preset password "8888".

1.5 RATING- It is used to set the rating of the disc.



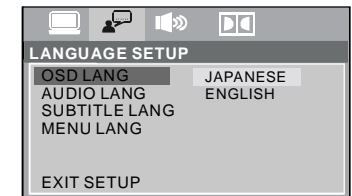
The higher the level is, the fewer the restricted discs are. If set at level 8, there is almost no disc restriction. If set at R level, maybe some types of discs can't be played, unless enter correct password, unlock and amend the age control level.

1.6 Default- Restore to factory settings.

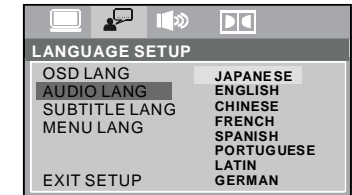

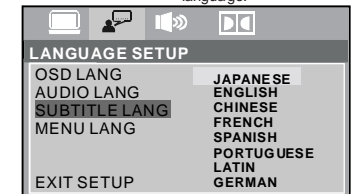
2.1 OSD LANGUAGE - to select the preferred OSD language.



2.2 AUDIO LANGUAGE - to select the preferred Audio language.



2.3 SUBTITLE LANGUAGE - to select the preferred Subtitle language.



2.4 MENU LANGUAGE - to select the preferred Menu language.



3 DOWN MIX- It is used to setup the Audio output. There are three options: LT/RT, STEREO and VSS.



- LT/RT: Choosing this setting, the sound will be output from left and right audio output terminal.
- STEREO: Choosing this setting, and while 5.1 channel sound playing, the two channels of signals will be output from the left and right soundtrack; when 2-channel sound playing, the stereo signal will be output.

Advanced Operation

Viewing from Different Angle (DVD only)

Some DVDs may contain scenes which have been shot simultaneously from a number of different angles. For these discs, the same scene can be viewed from each of these different angles using the ANGLE button. Press ANGLE button during play, the number of angles being played will be displayed on the screen, press the button to change to a different angle.

Initial Settings

Once the initial programming is entered it is entered in memory until changed, the player can always be operated under the same conditions. The settings will be retained in the memory until the settings are changed even after setting the player to power off mode.

Common procedure for initial settings

1. Press the "SETUP" button once.
2. Use the navigation buttons to move and select preferred option, and then press the "ENTER" button.
3. Use navigation buttons to move to another main setup items when not selecting any submenu option.
4. Press the "SETUP" button or choose "EXIT SETUP" item to close setup menu in any mode.

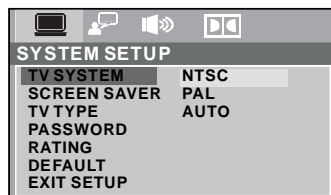

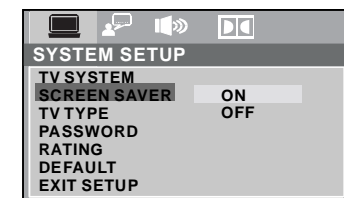
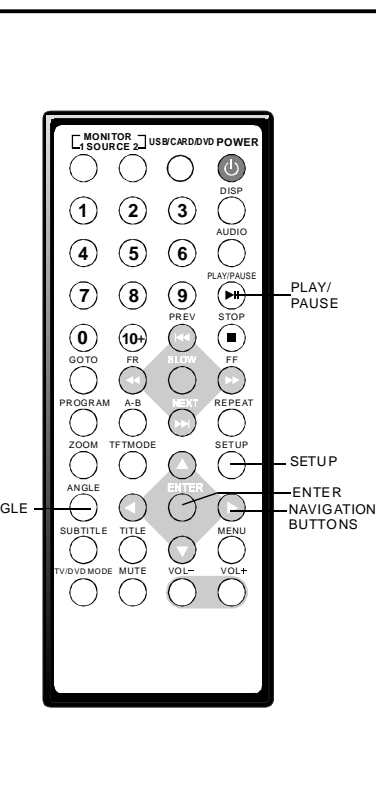

It is used to select the source for playing, there are three options: DISC, CARD and USB.

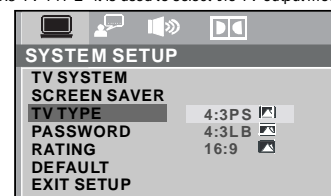
- 1.1 TV SYSTEM- It is used to select the TV system. There are two options: NTSC, PAL.



- 1.2 SCREEN SAVER- When your DVD player is in stop, tray open, or no disc state, the screen saver will turn on after 3 minutes. This feature is to protect the screen from damage. You can set the screen saver to on or off.

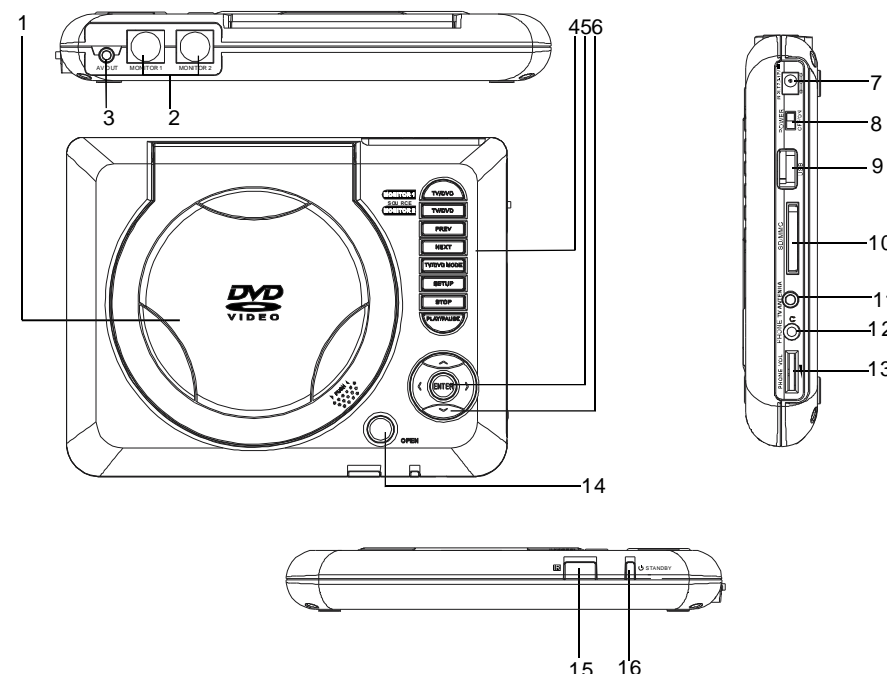


- 1.3 TV TYPE- it is used to select the TV output mode.



Control Reference Guide

Main Unit



- 1 **DISC Door** - Close by pushing the disc door.
- 2 **MONITOR 1 & 2 ports (output).**
- 3 **DVD AV OUT jack.**

- 4 **TV/DVD switches (MONITOR 1 & 2)**

PREV button - Press this button to go back to previous chapters / tracks.

NEXT button - Press this button to advance to next chapters / tracks.

TV/DVD MODE button - Press this button to select either TV or DVD/USB/SD operating source.

SETUP button - Press this button to open or close the SETUP menu of the unit.

STOP button - Press this button to stop playing the disc.

PLAY/PAUSE button - Press this button to pause playback of a disc when playing. Press this button again to resume the playback.

- 5 **ENTER button** - Press this button to confirm selections on a menu screen.

- 6 **Navigation buttons** - To move up, down, left or right.

- 7 **DC IN 12V jack** - Power input jack.

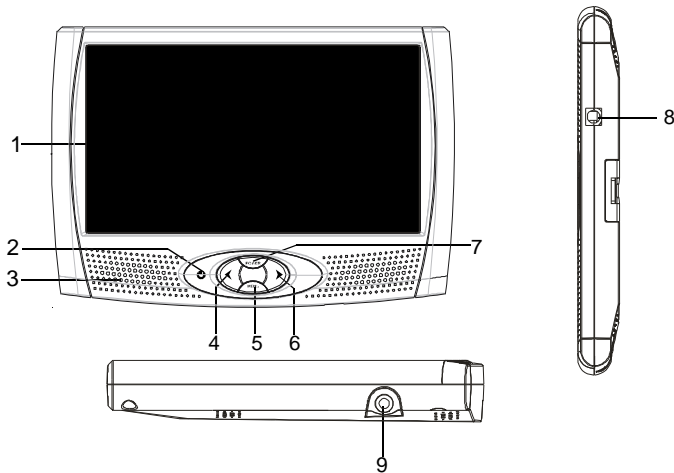

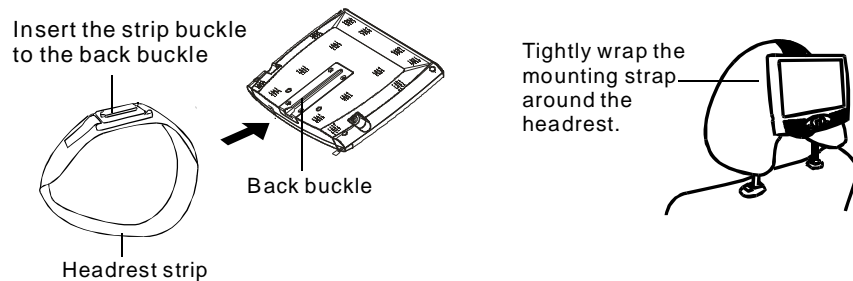


- 1 **Screen.**
- 2 **POWER indicator** - The LED will illuminate when the monitor is in standby mode.
- 3 **Built-in Speaker**
- 4 **LEFT /VOLUME- button**
- 5 **MENU button**-Press this button continuously to select (Contrast), / (16:9/4:3), (Sharpness), (Hue), (Color) , (Brightness), (volume).

- 6 **RIGHT button/VOLUME+**
- 7 **POWER button**-To set the monitor in standby mode.

Installation of Monitors

Use supplied mounting straps installing the monitors onto the seat back in a car.



- NOTE:** 1). This unit should not be used by driver, or left unsecured in the car while driving.
2). If this unit is being used in your car, be sure that it is secured or held safely and does not obstruct any safety device (i.e. airbag, seat belt etc.) that may be fitted.

Advanced Operation

Changing Subtitle Language (DVD only)

It is possible to change the subtitle language to a different language from the one selected at the initial settings.(This operation works only with discs on which multiple subtitle languages are recorded)

- 1.Press SUBTITLE button during play, the screen will display the current subtitle language.
 - 2.Press SUBTITLE button again to change subtitle languages or turn subtitle off.
- NOTE: When no subtitles are recorded, this function will not work.**

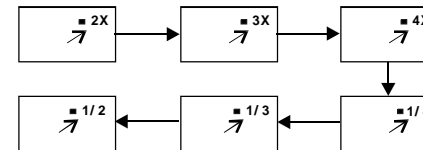

Zoom Play

This function allows you to view a motion or still picture.

- Press ZOOM button when playing, the screen shows:



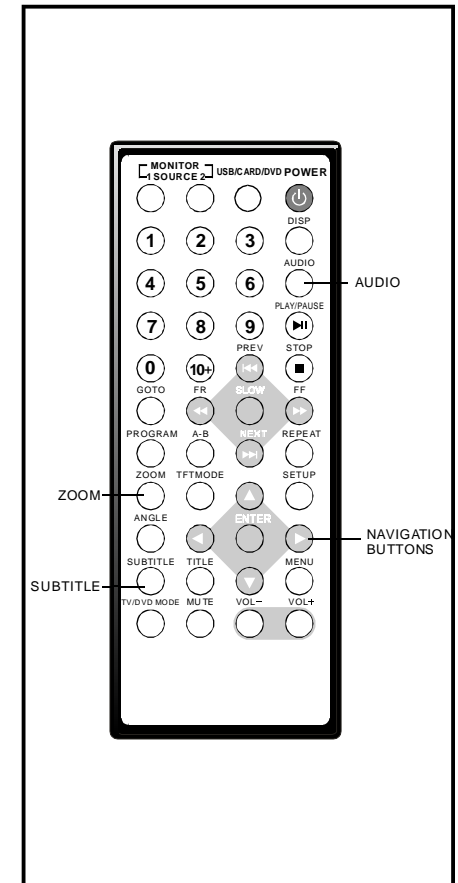
- Press navigation buttons to scroll across the enlarged picture.

Changing Audio Soundtrack Language(DVD/VCD disc)

It is possible to change the audio soundtrack language to a different language from the one selected at the initial settings (This operation works only with discs on which multiple audio soundtrack languages are recorded).

- Press AUDIO button while playing DVD disc, the screen will display the number of current sound track languages,pressing the button again will change the language.
- Pressing AUDIO button while playing VCD disc will change audio output mode: Left mono, Right mono, Mix-mono or Stereo audio soundtrack.

- NOTE:** When no soundtrack languages are recorded, this function will not work.
When the power is turned on or the disc is removed, the language heard is the one selected at the initial settings.



Advanced Operation

Repeat Play

Press the "REPEAT" button during play, it will repeat play one chapter or one title (for DVD), or repeat play track (for VCD/CD).

For DVD:

REP: [OFF]	Repeat off
REP: [CHAPTER]	Repeat chapter
REP: [TITLE]	Repeat title
REP: [ALL]	Repeat folder

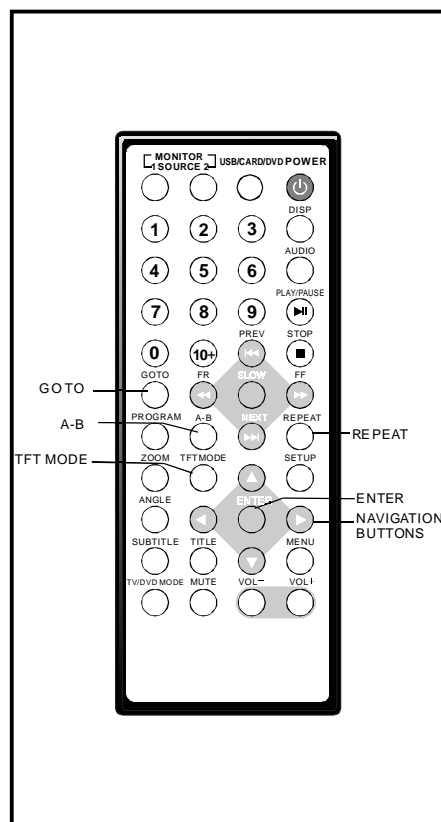
For VCD/CD disc (In the PBC OFF mode)

REP: OFF	Repeat off
REP: REP 1	Repeat 1 track
REP: REP ALL	Repeat all track

A-B Repeat play

Repeating sections between two specified points (A-B repeat)

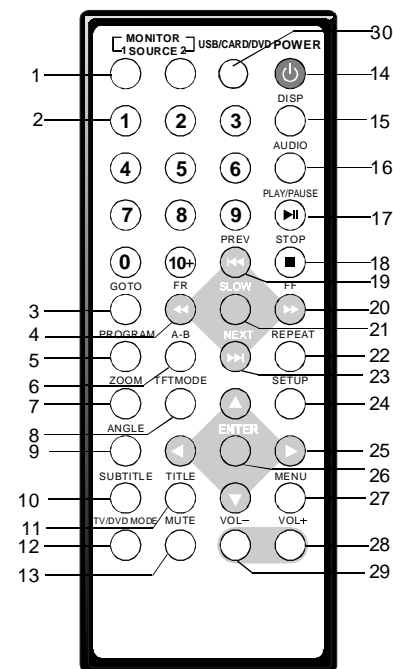
1. Press the "A-B" button during play at the point where repeat play is to be started (A).
2. Press "A-B" button at the point where repeat play is to be ended (B). Repeat play of the selection between points A and B starts.
3. Press "A-B" button to return to normal play.



Control Reference Guide

Remote Control

- 1 **Monitor source1 and 2** - Press the MONITOR SOURCE 1 or 2 button to select TV or DVD/USB/SD.
- 2 **NUMERIC buttons** - Press these buttons to input the numeric information, such as track number, chapter number and so on.
- 3 **GO TO button** - Press this button to set the player ;play disc starting time.
- 4 **FR button** - Press this button to play the disc backward at speeds: **x2, x4, x8, x20**.
- 5 **PROGRAM button** - Press this button to set up the memory order of chapters or titles (for DVD) or tracks (for VCD/CD).
- 6 **A-B button** - Press this button to repeat sections between two specific points (A-B).
- 7 **ZOOM button** - Press this button to enlarge picture size, max. to **X4**, or shrink picture size, min. to **X1/4**.
- 8 **TFT MODE button** - Press this button to adjust CONTRAST, HUE, SATURATION and SHARPNESS.
- 9 **ANGLE button** - Press this button to display the angle number and change to different angles (for DVD).
- 10 **SUBTITLE button** - Press this button to display and change Subtitle languages (for DVD).
- 11 **TITLE button** - Press this button to return to the Title Menu (for DVD).
- 12 **TV/DVD MODE** - Press this button to select either TV or DVD/USB/SD operating source.
- 13 **MUTE button** - Press this button to mute the sound.
- 14 **POWER button** - Press this button to turn on the main unit and monitors or set them in standby mode.
- 15 **DISP button** - Press this button continuously during playback, the screen will display all the playing information, such as elapsed time, remaining time and so on.
- 16 **AUDIO button** - Press this button to select sound track.
- 17 **PLAY/PAUSE button** - Press this button to start or pause playing the disc.
- 18 **STOP button** - Press this button to stop playing the disc.
- 19 **PREV button** - Press this button to skip to the previous chapter or track.
- 20 **FF button** - Press this button to play the disc forward at speeds: **x2, x4, x8, x20**.
- 21 **SLOW button** - Press this button to play disc at speeds: **1/2, 1/4, 1/5, 1/6, 1/7**.
- 22 **REPEAT button** - Press this button to repeat playing one chapter, title or the whole disc (for DVD), or repeat playing the current track or the whole disc (for VCD/CD).
- 23 **NEXT button** - Press this button to skip to the next chapter (for DVD) or track (for VCD/CD).
- 24 **SETUP button** - Press this button to enter initial settings menu (TV/DVD/USB/SD).
- 25 **NAVIGATION buttons** - Press these buttons to move the cursor up, down, left or right.

- Ensure that this player and other equipment to be connected are set to the standby mode or off and disconnect the AC adaptor before connection.

- Ensure that you observe the colour coding when connecting audio and video cables.

Remote Control Preparation

Battery Installation

Insert the batteries while observing the correct (+) and (-) polarities as illustrated at right(Fig 1).

Service life of batteries

- The batteries normally last for about one year although this depends on how often, and for what operations, the remote control is used.
- If the remote control fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the batteries.
- Use one CR 2025 type battery.

Note:

- Do not use rechargeable (Ni-Cd) battery.
- Do not attempt to recharge, short-circuit, disassemble, heat or throw the batteries into the fire.
- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the battery.

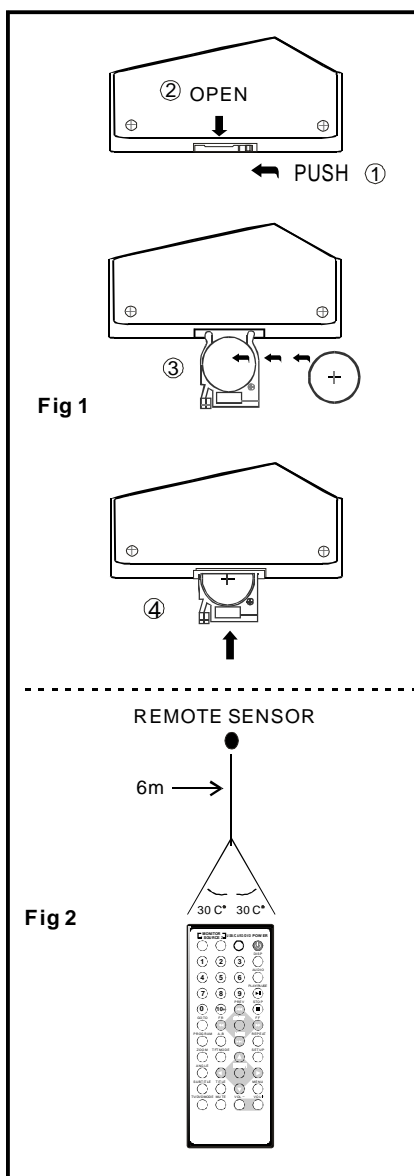

Remote control operation

1. Remove the protective plastic tab before operating the remote control(Fig 2).
2. Point the remote control from no more than about 6m from the DVD player and within about 60° of the front of the DVD player(Fig 2).

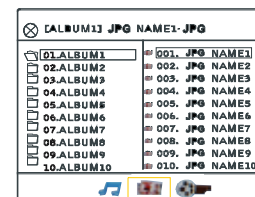
NOTE:

- The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.
- Do not point bright lights at remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control and the remote control sensor.

JPEG CD

- For JPEG picture CD, select the folder you want to play using the navigation buttons and press ENTER button to confirm.

2. Press either MONITOR 1 or 2 to select DVD player.

NOTE: 1). Make sure that all the connections including connections to monitors, AC adaptor etc. have been completed before switching the POWER switch to the "ON" position.

2). After switching the unit "OFF", wait several seconds before turning the unit back "ON". The unit may malfunction if the unit is switched back "ON" immediately after switching "OFF". If a malfunction occurs, switch the unit "OFF" and wait several seconds before turning it "ON" again.
